

Bible Study Activity with North Dakota Group

Summary of Activities

Monday:

- Using a bilingual coloring book with the theme of God is Love, children color first pages
- Marilyn reads the Spanish sentence to the children that explains the first 2 pages.
- Children are given a colored string and a cross to make a necklace.
- In a sitting circle, children sing song in English about God loves you
- Play with balloons, batting them into the air, keeping them from hitting the floor
- Pastor Gaspar tells a story in Quechua about God loves you and the children pray with Gaspar
- Children receive a paper cross to color.
- Snacks are given out
- The children go home with their coloring book



Tuesday:

- Using a different coloring book with the theme of Proverbs, children color first pages
- Luis reads the Spanish sentence to the children that explains the first 2 pages.
- Children are given pieces of a butterfly to put together and attach to their coloring book
- Children sing “Head, Shoulders, Knees, and Toes” in a circle



- Pastor Gaspar tells another story in Quechua and the children pray with Gaspar. Gaspar leads a song in Spanish that most of the children know.



- All go outside and make a circle. Two soccer balls are passed around
- Group is divided into younger children and older children. Lori/Amber work with the small group of younger children. Marilyn/Luís/Gaspar work with the larger group of older children. First, the older group passes the ball back and forth, keeping the ball in the circle, we move to two lines passing it back and forth down the line.

Wednesday:

- Using the Proverbs book, children continue coloring
- Luis reads another Spanish sentence to the children from the book.
- Children are given a short, pointed stick to scratch off the black covering on a new cross that is given out. Underneath are very pretty colors



- Children sit in a double circle (smaller children in middle) and sing the song from the first day.
- Children start playing with balloons.
- Luis shows the video of a N. Dakota Sunday School class singing a song.

- Lori organizes a train and with everyone following, they weave around the tables then go outside and weave on the lawn and then move down to the large patio.
- In a circle they play “Ring around the rosie; pocket full of posies; ashes, ashes; they all fall down”. They also sing the song from the first day and “Head, Shoulders, Knees, and Toes”
- Children move back inside and snacks are given out.
- One by one, children are called to get their Proverbs book, their packet of crayons and other treats.
